
## Kitten Crib Spread

Embroider or applique this kitten on white 9-inch blocks. Alternate these blocks with plain colored ones. For a spread 45" x 54" without a border, you will need 15 kitten blocks and 15 plain blocks. This gives 5 blocks in width and 6 in length. Some of the kittens may be facing one way and some another. It would be wise to make two patterns; trace one and then reverse pattern for the second. The quilting lines should be about one inch apart on this size quilt. You can make any desired size quilt by adding more blocks. Border should be the same color as that for plain blocks, about a 3-inch border is suggested or a narrow binding may be used.

## **COLOR SUGGESTIONS:**

Gray kitten with blue eyes, pink nose, whiskers and lines for ears black, make bow blue or pink. Another might be buff with amber eyes, or black with green eyes. A blue-eyed white kitten might be embroidered on a gray, black or dark blue square. Allow for turn under if kitten motif is to be appliquéd.
