



Basket of Hearts

15" applique quilt block

Pattern provided by Vicki Haninger

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DIRECTIONS:

Print pattern onto cardstock and cut out on lines, or print pattern onto 8.5" x 11" freezer paper sheets. Print one on regular paper to use as a placement guide.

Trace around basket bottom on the wrong side of fabric; placing center on fold, or iron FP to fabric. Add a 1/4" seam allowance beyond the marked lines and cut out.

Lightly mark the placement of the basket and handle on quilt block. Bias binding can be used for the handle. Be sure to applique the **inside of the curve** first for the best results.

Fold under edges of basket and hearts; press and baste. Applique one heart in the center (see yellow heart); overlap bottom part of heart with basket bottom; and overlap ends of handle to enclose the raw edges.

Add four of each size heart on the basket (as shown in diagram).
